- Bus or walk to CRLA (1.5+ miles)



Program Costs

COD students = \$3,700 plus tuition (\$864-1,008 dependent on language placement) ICISP students = \$4,664 (\$3,700 + \$864 instructional fee + \$100 ICISP administrative fee)
