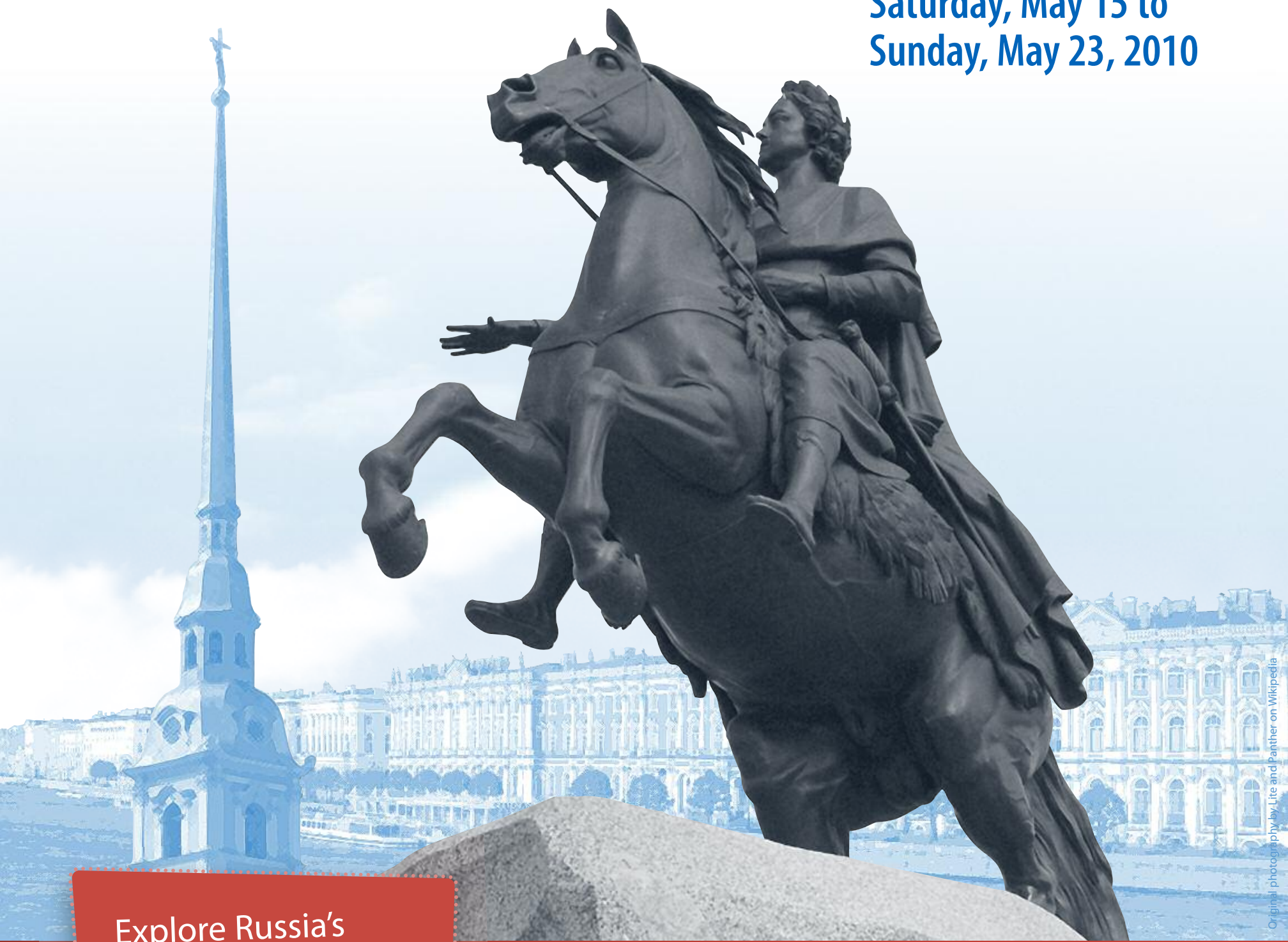


# RUSSIA

## Spring in St. Petersburg

Explore Russia's "Window to the West" next spring. Visit palaces, museums and historical sites that illuminate St. Petersburg, Russia's past and present.

This experience, led by Ben Whisenhunt, Ph.D., professor of history at College of DuPage, includes St. Petersburg, area palaces and nearby sites.

In 300-year-old St. Petersburg, founded by Peter the Great, see the world famous Hermitage Museum, the Peter and Paul Fortress, palaces of the tsars, St. Isaac's Cathedral, Novgorod and much more.

The estimated fee of \$3,450 includes air and ground transportation, accommodations, visa support, some meals and most entrance fees. Tuition for three credit hours is extra.
