

# Islands to Oases:

## PARKS OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA

Wednesday, Feb. 3 to Tuesday, Feb. 9, 2010



Visit, hike and explore the two very diverse national parks of Southern California – the last great wilderness in the continental United States.

The Mojave and Sonora deserts meet in Joshua Tree National Park – a park known for the groves of eccentric Joshua trees. Hit the trail and discover surreal rock formations, dark night skies and fan palm oases. View gray whale migration on the way to Channel Islands National Park and uncover what some call the North American Galapagos.

The fee is \$1,165 and includes air/land/water transportation, admissions and lodging. Tuition for one credit is extra. The class meets Wednesday, Jan. 20, from 6 to 8 p.m.
