

# How the College of DuPage Works

## Board of Trustees

The Board consists of seven members elected by the community and a student trustee elected by the students at C.O.D. Collectively the Board makes all decisions for the institution's major expenditures and policy.

## President

The President of College of DuPage sets a vision and focus for the College to run by and grow. The President works with the Board, administrators and faculty to make the progress in C.O.D. run efficiently. The President also works with state politicians and other presidents to ensure that community colleges are well represented and benefit from new legislation.

## Administrators

The administrators work in specific areas to oversee and work toward changes and maintenance in the college. They also report information of their area to the Board.

## Faculty/Classified Staff

The Faculty creates the curriculum offered by the college and serves on committees and teams to represent specific needs. They form a faculty senate that works together to best represent their opinions as a union. The Classified Staff fills all positions in the school that are not teaching or administrative.

## Students

Students form the bulk of the college, and they are represented by the Student Trustee, by the faculty and by speaking directly to the Board. The new Student Leadership Council also gathers student opinion and works with the Student Trustee.
