

The Department of Defense Authorization Act of 1983, Pub. L. 97-252, Sec. 113 requires that all males must be registered with Selective Service to receive Title IV Federal Aid. Illinois Selective Service State law (110 ILCS 5/30-17/1) mandates that students who receive any student assistance, waiver, etc. funded in whole or part with state funds (including institutional assistance at state schools) provide the school with the same statements or documentation. Before College of DuPage can process any additional financial aid awards, please complete the following Statement of Selective Service Registration Compliance.

Statement of Selective Service Registration Status

Check the appropriate box(es).

- I certify that I am registered with Selective Service. Submit a copy of your Selective Service Acknowledgment Card or proof of registration. (Print out online verification at www.sss.gov.)
- I certify that I am not required to be registered with Selective Service because:
 - I am a female.
 - I am in the armed services on active duty. (NOTE: Does not apply to members of the Reserves and National Guard who are not on active duty.)
 - I have not yet reached my 18th (eighteenth) birthday.
 - I was born before 1960.
 - I am a resident of the Federated States of Micronesia, or the Republic of the Marshall Islands, or a citizen of the Republic of Palau.
- I believe I am **exempt** from the requirement to register because I am a noncitizen who first entered the United States at the age of 26 years or older. ***I am providing official documentation with this form which confirms that I was past the age required to register when I entered the United States. (See below.)**** I understand that if requested, I will have to obtain the Status Information Letter from the Selective Service and submit it to the College of DuPage Office of Student Financial Aid.

* Official documentation of the date of entry into the United States is the following: entry stamp on passport, I-94 with entry stamp on it, or a letter from the Department of Homeland Security indicating the date you entered the United States. ***The Resident Alien Card (Green Card) is not valid proof of the date of entry into the United States.***
