

G.E.D. 0830: United States and State of Illinois Constitution

Need help studying for the G.E.D. Constitution Test? If so, then this class is for YOU!

This four-week course prepares students to pass the G.E.D. Constitution Test. The test covers the United States Constitution and State of Illinois Constitution. This course organizes all of the material necessary to pass the test into nine units. Unit quizzes are used to assess student understanding of the material. Students should expect to spend approximately six hours each week completing the coursework.

Students interested in this course must have access to a computer with Internet capabilities. This course is offered through the Blackboard course management system.
