GED Online offers you the opportunity to review for the GED test independently, at your own pace. Students schedule time to meet with the instructor periodically to take practice tests to determine readiness. Preparation can take as little as 4 weeks.

How do I enroll?

- First, take placement (TABE) tests to determine your skill levels. Minimum scores of 9.0 in Reading and 8.0 in Math are needed. Contact the COD Testing Office (630)942-2852 for times and locations for testing.
- Make an appointment with the GED Program Manager, Sherry May, by calling 630-942-3803 to be sure the class is right for you.
- Enrollment can take place any time up to the last four weeks of the term.
