

C.O.D./Northwood University Articulation Agreement

College of DuPage and Northwood University recently signed an articulation agreement that will enable C.O.D. students to earn their associate's degrees and then complete their bachelor's degrees at Northwood's Lisle campus.

Based in Midland, Michigan, Northwood University also maintains a Lisle Program Center at 6010 South Route 53.

Through the new and expanded articulation agreement, C.O.D. students can earn their bachelor's degrees from Northwood once they have completed associate's degrees in any of these disciplines: criminal justice, culinary arts, emergency medical services, foodservice administration, facility management, office technology information (executive assistant), meeting and event planning, and travel and tourism.

Students who complete their Associate in Applied Science degrees in any of these areas will have the opportunity to transfer up to 96 semester hours to Northwood to complete their Bachelor of Business Administration degrees. This "3-plus-1 agreement" enables students to take their first three years at C.O.D. at reduced tuition cost and then finish their last year at Northwood in an accelerated learning format.
