

Dental Hygiene Program Requirements

***The following general education and prerequisite courses will be required for admission to and for graduation from the C.O.D. Dental Hygiene program. Students must have a cumulative 3.0 GPA or better in all prerequisite science courses for admission into the program. In addition, microbiology, chemistry, and anatomy and physiology must have been taken within five years of the application date. Preference will be given to College of DuPage District 502 residents.
