1. Complete the general College of DuPage Application for Admissions and know your COD ID Student Number. Link to the online application at <https://admissions.cod.edu>.
2. Complete this Engineering Pathways program application packet.
 - Download and type information. Complete online and **print** a copy to include with your packet.
 - Attach a copy of your seventh semester high school transcript (an unofficial seventh semester transcript provided to you by your high school counselor is accepted.)
 - Include your personal statement.
 - Attach copies of ALL COD Placement Test results in the subjects listed, regardless of ACT scores. COD placement tests are available at COD main campus and select COD Centers. To learn more about Testing Center hours, visit: www.cod.edu/admission/testing/hours.aspx:
 - i. Reading (ACCUPLACER)
