Who can apply?

- High school seniors planning on enrolling for the first time to College of DuPage.
- Students must be accepted into the program.

How does the program work?

- Students must be enrolled at College of DuPage full-time (at least 12 credit hours) each semester in coursework that meets the College of Engineering at the University of Illinois transfer course requirements toward the intended baccalaureate degree.
- Students must complete required courses.
- It is recommended that students complete the College of DuPage Associate in Engineering Science (AES) degree.
- Students must receive no less than a B in any required courses taken at College of DuPage.

Application process

- Submit general Admissions application from College of DuPage
- Complete required exam scores for Reading, Writing and Math
- Download and print Engineering Pathways Application at cod.edu/pathways
- Submit complete Engineering Pathways Application with test scores to the Admissions and Outreach Office, Student Services Center (SSC), Room 2207.
