<b>Academic Warning</b>	Attempted less than 12 credits with cumulative GPA less than 1.5	Meeting with counselor <b>strongly recommended</b> to develop <i>Success Agreement</i> . Standards of Academic Progress discussed.	
<b>Probation I</b>	Attempted 12 or more credits with cumulative GPA and semester GPA less than 2.0	Appointment with counselor <b>required</b> . Completion of <i>Success Agreement</i> <b>required</b> . A hold will remain on student's record until cumulative GPA reaches 2.0.	Student will no longer be on probation once cumulative GPA is 2.0. <b>Continued Probation:</b> Student has previously been on probation and will continue on probation with registration subject to requirements outlined in <i>Success Agreement</i> until cumulative GPA is 2.0.
<b>Probation II</b>	After one semester on Probation I status with cumulative GPA and semester GPA less than 2.0	Appointment with counselor <b>required</b> . Completion of <i>Success Agreement</i> <b>required</b> . Enrollment <b>limited to not more than 13 credits</b> including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Course choice equal to number of credit courses successfully completed with C grade or higher during previous semester.</li> </ul> And/or if no courses were successfully completed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Repeat of courses with D or F grade.</li> <li>• Developmental courses (0 level).</li> <li>• Career/personal development courses, i.e. Education 105, 110, 115, Human Services 105, Social Science 110, Field &amp; Experiential Learning or Inter-disciplinary Studies &amp; Special Project.</li> <li>• Studio/activity courses, i.e. physical education, art, music.</li> </ul> A hold will remain on student's record until cumulative GPA reaches 2.0. <b>Dropped for Low Scholarship I (Suspension)</b>	After one semester on Probation II status with cumulative GPA and semester GPA less than 2.0	<b>One semester automatic suspension.</b> When grade reports are issued, student will be withdrawn from current semester courses and will be issued a refund. A hold will remain on student's record until cumulative GPA reaches 2.0.	After serving one semester automatic suspension, if reinstated, student follows Probation II status limitations.  <b>Neither reinstatement nor a full-time course load is guaranteed.</b>
