As soon as you know when your event will take place, e-mail 3d@cod.edu with event name, location, date, and description and ask to be listed in “Upcoming 3D Activities.”

Earn Participation Points!

Everyone in the College of DuPage community is encouraged to participate in activities and events that address the focus of the year, Nurture | Nature. E-mail 3D at 3d@cod.edu with your full name, preferred e-mail address, event name, and the same 5-digit pin number of your own choosing every time you organize, attend, and/or volunteer at a 3D-supported event listed in "Upcoming 3D Activities" on the 3D website. In the e-mail subject line, put “**3D participant**”. We will maintain a 3D Participation Database that awards points for each mode of engagement:

Activity/Event Organizer	50 pts
Activity/Event Volunteer	20 pts
Attendee	10 pts

Here is an example format for e-mailing about your participation in a 3D activity or event:
