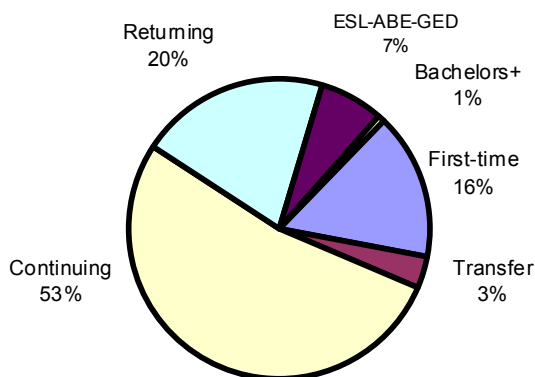
Fall Semester 2009 Credit Student Demographics

Gender Distribution

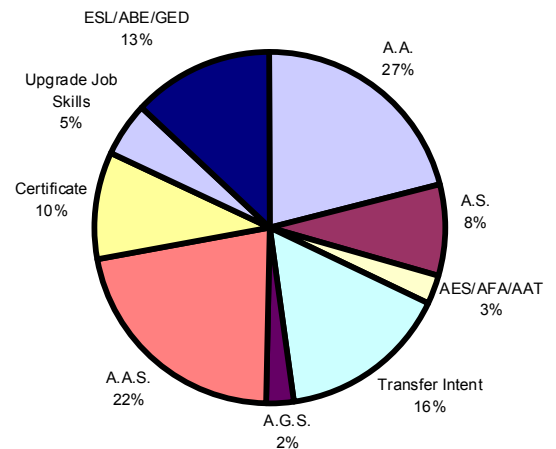

Age of C.O.D. Credit Students: *The average (mean) age of credit students is 28 years, the age falling exactly in the center of the age range (median) is 23 years, and the age that appears most frequently (mode) is 19 years.*

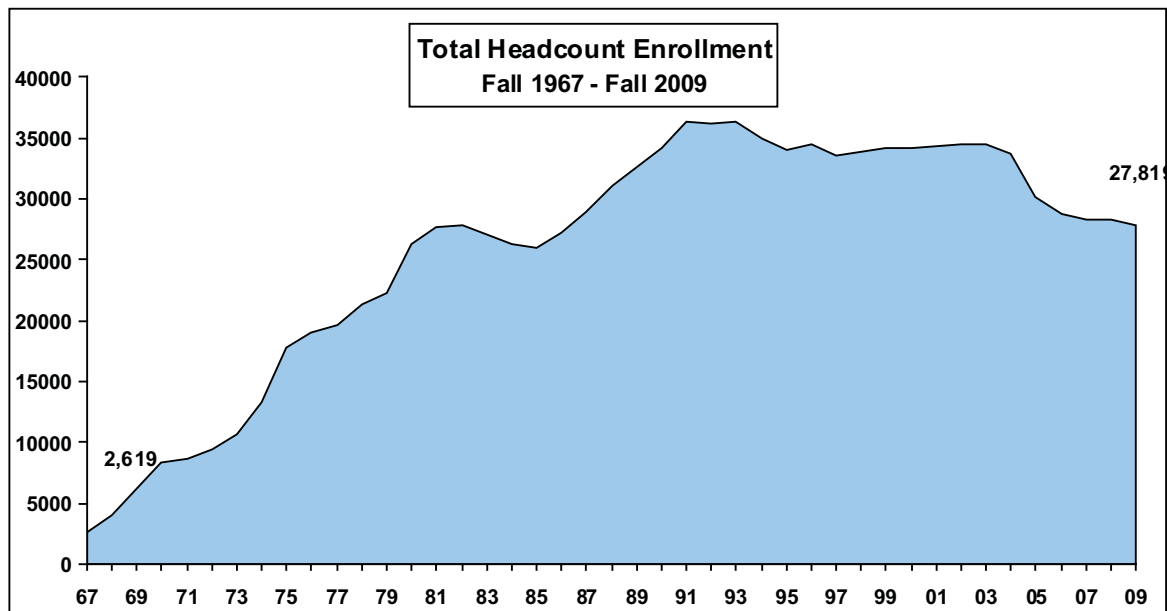
Course Load of C.O.D. Students: *There are 10,591 (39%) full-time students (12+ credit hours) and 16,492 (61%) part-time students. Full-time enrollment has increased by 7.2 percent over last fall's full-time enrollment. Of the part-time students, 8,320 (31%) were enrolled in fewer than 6 credit hours; 8,172 (30%) were enrolled in more the six credit hours, but fewer than 12 credit hours.*
