The candidates will have the opportunity to discuss their platform in return the members of the SLC will be given the opportunity to ask questions.

If necessary you will be notified either by email or phone of any changes that should occur on any part of this election packet. It would be **in your best intentions** to stop by the SLC office briefly to ensure that you are knowledgeable about any information that pertains to the election.
