STUDENT BODY PRESIDENT

The Student Body President serves as the primary representative of all students. The President presides at meetings of the Student Leadership Council. The Student President meets directly with the Administration and is the voice for the student body. Both the President and VP serve a one-year term from April of the Spring Semester to May of the following year.

STUDENT BODY VICE-PRESIDENT

The Student Body Vice-President serves as the primary officer in charge of College-Wide Committee representation of the Student Leadership Council and assists the Student Body President. Both the President and Vice-President attend the Board of Trustees meetings.

STUDENT TRUSTEE

The Student Trustee is elected for a one year term and provides a student perspective to the College's Board of Trustees. The Student Trustee has the same rights, privileges and responsibilities as all trustees, except that of a binding vote; the C.O.D. Student Trustee gives an advisory vote prior to the other trustees' votes.
