PRESIDENT AND VICE-PRESIDENT ELECTION PACKET

Dear SLC Prospective Candidate,

Thank you for your interest in becoming an active part of the Student Leadership Council! This letter will provide you some guidelines to successfully being placed on the ballot and winning your election. Note that you must have a CGPA of 2.5 if you wish to run for SLC President or Vice-President.

Please **be aware of all deadlines!** A timeline for the election is within the pages of this packet, I advise that you observe this time line. **Read all rules** pertaining to the election and campaigning procedures. Please ensure that all members of your campaigning staff are aware of the rules that pertain to the election and campaigning process, for **you will be held responsible** for all of their actions. **PLEASE NOTE:** The president and vice president are **NOT** elected as a team. Each officer must be elected in your own right. While you may choose to campaign as a team, there is the possibility that your running-mate may be elected, and you not.

All Candidates MUST attend the Candidate Information Session on Monday, March 16th at 2 p.m. in the Student Activities office. It is the responsibility of the candidate to inform Andie Richmond at ext. 2644 if they have a conflict and need to reschedule ahead of time.

We **strongly suggest** that you attend SLC workshops, service learning projects, and voting meetings. Attendance to these meeting and any activity will help you become more familiar with the procedure of this organization, as well as show your passion and dedication to the organization, its members, and to the student body. Meetings are held regularly every Tuesday at 4pm in SRC 1550 (SLC Office).
