A College of DuPage transfer student must have a 3.0 overall gpa on a 4.0 scale and a 'C' or above in all major coursework to transfer in to SIUC at the junior level. If a student does not meet these requirements, they must submit a portfolio for admission and placement.

*For a two year completion rate, the second physics class should be taken prior to the beginning of the fall semester at SIUC. It can be taken over the summer at COD (Physics 1202) or at SIUC (Phys 203B and 253B).

It is recommended that students take additional core curriculum classes during summer semesters to lighten the loads during fall and spring semesters and to try to avoid scheduling conflicts.
