## *Some important notes:*

\*\*If you need help filing your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) please be sure to have the following income/asset information with you. *If you are a dependent student please be sure to bring your parent's information too:*

- Student's driver's license and social security number
- Student's alien registration number, if not a U.S. citizen
- 2004 Federal Tax Return (1040, 1040A, 1040EZ, 1040 Telefile) and W-2 forms (student and parent for dependent students)
- Records of untaxed income: social security benefits, Aid to Dependent Children (ADC), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), veteran benefits, or any other untaxed income.
- Records of business; farm and assets (stocks, bonds and other investments)
- Current mortgage statements for properties other than the family's principal residence
- Current bank statements

\*\*Filing your FAFSA on the Web, please be sure to have a Department of Education PIN Number. If you do not have a PIN, you and your parents (if dependent) should apply for a PIN ahead of time by going to [www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov). This PIN will serve as your electronic signature.
