

THE JOHN BELUSHI/SECOND CITY SCHOLARSHIP

2007-2008 Scholarship Application Information

The John Belushi/Second City Scholarship Fund was established in 1983 in the name and memory of John Belushi -- actor, comedian, and entertainer -- and Second City, the Chicago-based comedic theatre group. This memorial scholarship, in honor of College of DuPage's former student, provides recipients with full tuition and fees at the College of DuPage, and is available to both acting and technical theatre students.

Acting applicants should prepare a 1-2 minute monologue of contemporary theatre, either comedic or dramatic, as well as file a complete application with the Student Financial Aid Office. Technical theatre applicants should also file a complete application, and will then interview with theatre faculty at the college. All applicants must include two recommendations from an educator and/or employer, to be included with the application.

Candidates must have sufficient experience and background in the performing arts or technical theatre by which talent or potential talent can be determined, and

- be a high school graduate
- reside in District 502
- show financial need.

The materials must be postmarked or received in the Student Financial Aid Office no later than June 1, 2006 in order to receive consideration by the selection committee of the John Belushi/Second City Scholarship Fund. If an audition or personal interview is desired by the selection committee, you will be notified within two weeks of the deadline date.
