

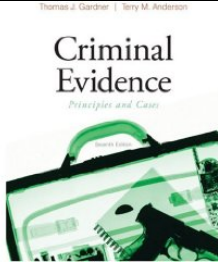

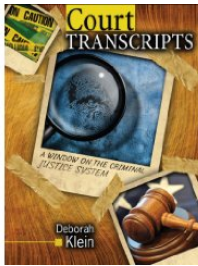
COURSE DESCRIPTION
