

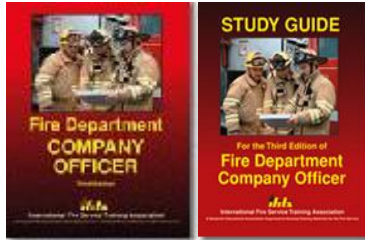
FIRE SCIENCE 2254
