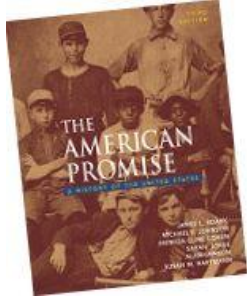
History of the United States to 1865

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Survey of American history from the Pre-Columbian era through the U.S. Civil War: peoples and origins, colonial development, revolution, establishment of the U.S. Constitution, Early Republic, Age of Reform, and Civil War. Prerequisite: None. (3 credit hours)

COURSE MATERIALS



James L. Roark, et. al. *The American Promise: A History of the United States*, combined volume or volume I, to 1877.

You will be assigned readings from the textbook for each of the three units of the class. There are links to the text's excellent online Study Guide which you should use to prepare for the Multiple Choice Quizzes on each unit and for the Essay Exam on each unit.

Primary Sources (documents from the period) are housed in the course. Discussions, the Midterm Essay, and the Final Essay are based on the textbook and these primary source readings.
