

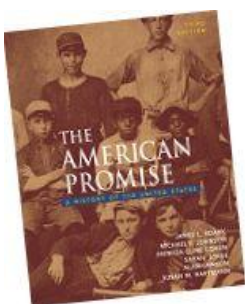
HISTORY 1140

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Survey of U.S. history from Reconstruction to the Present: Reconstruction, Industrial Revolution, Progressive Era Politics, Problems of 20th Century include economic, political, cultural, international, and social changes in the modern U.S. including 20th century major wars, Depression Era, and the Cold War Era. Prerequisite: None. (3 credit hours)
