

How to cite from Short Story Criticism (SSC) in MLA Style format

When citing an essay that originally appeared in a journal, magazine or newspaper and is reprinted in SSC use the following model:

Jones, William M. "The Plot as Search." *Studies in Short Fiction*. 5.1 (1967): 37-43. Rpt. in *Short Story Criticism: Excerpts from Criticism of the Works of Short Fiction Writers*. Ed. Laurie Lanzen Harris and Sheila Fitzgerald. Vol. 1. Detroit: Gale, 1988. 484-86. Print.

When citing an essay that originally appeared in a book and is reprinted in SSC, use the following model:
