

## Articulation Agreement

Effective today, The Illinois Institute of Art-Schaumburg and College of DuPage agree to enter into an articulation agreement to benefit those College of DuPage students who have successfully completed an Associate of Applied Science in Motion Picture/Television - Animation and wish to pursue a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Media Arts & Animation. Students must complete the agreement as outlined below.

The awarding of credits shall be based upon a completed application from the student and a review/evaluation of the following:

1. Student must earn a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average of “C” or better for the Associate of Applied Science to transfer into The Illinois Institute of Art-Schaumburg.
2. Student must have completed the degree within five years prior to matriculation at The Illinois Institute of Art-Schaumburg.
3. Student must be fully accepted into The Illinois Institute of Art-Schaumburg as a baccalaureate seeking student in Media Arts & Animation.
4. Official transcripts from College of DuPage must be submitted to the Transcript Evaluator at The Illinois Institute of Art-Schaumburg prior to matriculation.
5. The Illinois Institute of Art-Schaumburg will accept a maximum of 88 quarter credits as transfer.

This agreement is specifically designed for students who wish to attend The Illinois Institute of Art-Schaumburg. This agreement allows the student to transfer in 48 credits within the Media Arts & Animation program (specified on Table A), 16 foundations credits, and 24 general education credits, a total of 88 quarter credits. In order to fulfill the requirements of this agreement, the student is responsible for successfully completing the following courses at College of DuPage.



Each party also agrees to notify the other of any changes in their respective program curriculum that would necessitate a re-evaluation of the articulation agreement.


