During the semester you will maintain a journal which will include:

85 POINTS- Notes and from all lectures- Missing lectures will receive 0. The notes should contain class date and lecture topic. Each building should be fully identified; this will give you the necessary information for the quizzes. Complete notes will include the major points of the lecture, characteristics of style, significant features of structure, related works etc.

A complete id includes:

- Name
- Location
- Date
- Architect (if not attributed state "unknown")
- Style

All movies that are viewed in class should have notes. These will help you as you write the essays and prepare for the essay portion of the quizzes.

85 POINTS- Sketches from all lectures- Missing lectures will receive 0. You should sketch all buildings discussed during class lecture. Sketches should be quick, they are to help you develop sketching skills as well as to force you to visually study and analyze the structure during the lecture. The process of sketching will help you remember the buildings for the quizzes.

Your journal should be kept in a permanent format. ***A spiral notebook is not acceptable.*** Possible options are a bound sketchbook, heavy covered spiral sketchbook, bound grid books etc.
