Adult Fast Track (AFT) students who earn the Associate in Arts degree and who meet the admission criteria for Concordia University will be admitted to Concordia's **Institute of Professional Studies** to complete a Bachelor of Arts degree in the **Accelerated Degree Program for Adults**.

AFT Associate in Arts courses can apply to Concordia's Bachelor of Arts degree as indicated. Once the specified number of hours has been met in a Concordia general education category, additional courses from that category will apply as elective credit.

The total credit hours needed for the Bachelor of Arts in Organizational Management is **128 sem.hrs.** AFT students who have earned the Associate in Arts(64 s.h.)and are admitted to Concordia’s Accelerated Degree Program will be permitted to transfer a maximum of **73 semester hours** from COD.

Additional courses needed at Concordia to earn the Bachelor of Arts in Organizational Management are:

Organizational Management major:

although transfer credit can be awarded in the major, it is recommended that students take these courses at Concordia. The courses are offered in an 18-month cohort schedule, meeting once a week for four hours.

Mission Specific Courses:

(3 course requirement; 9 s.h.)

One course (3 s.h.)

required course for all students; no transfer permitted. Included in the 18-month cohort schedule

Two theology courses (6 s.h.)

may be taken at COD up to the 73 s.h. transfer maximum; or taken at Concordia. Applicable COD courses for this area: REL.ST. 1100,1110,1120,1150.

Additional Electives:

(19 s.h.)

may be taken at COD up to the73s.h.transfer maximum, or courses are available at Concordia in an accelerated format. *Credit for Prior Learning* may also be applied in this area.
