

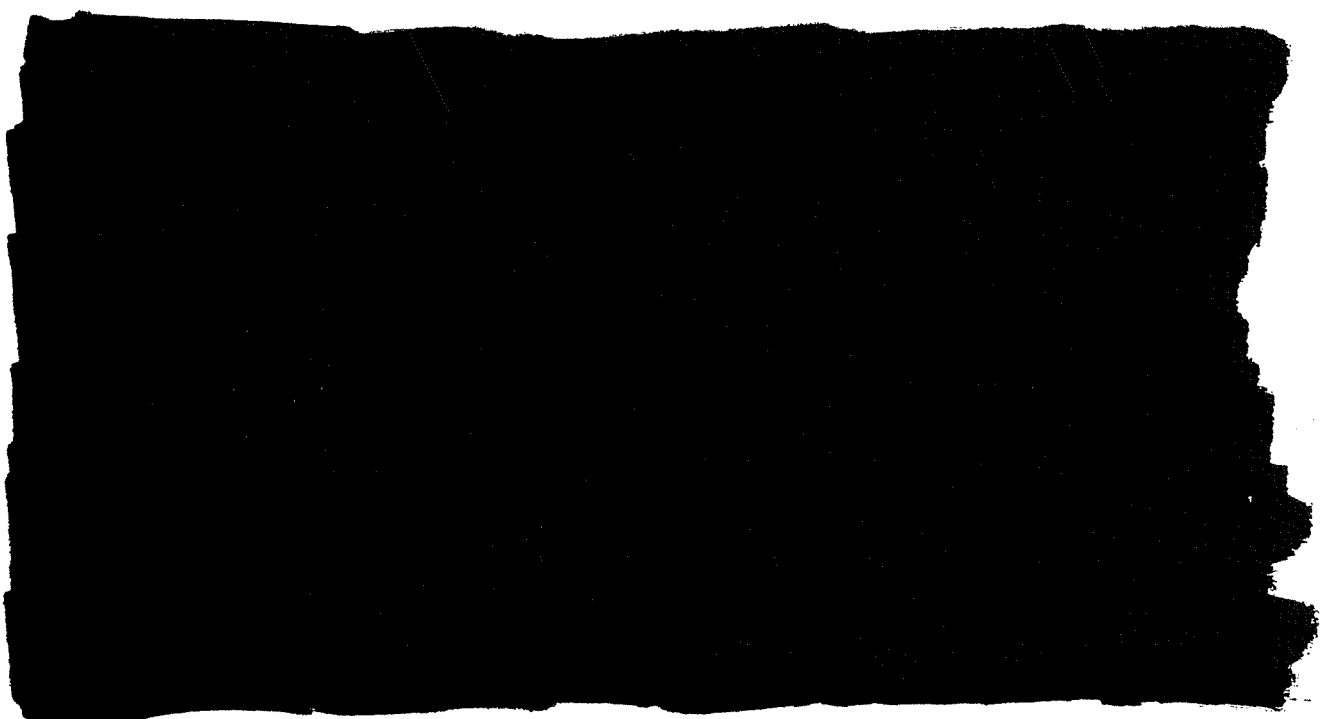

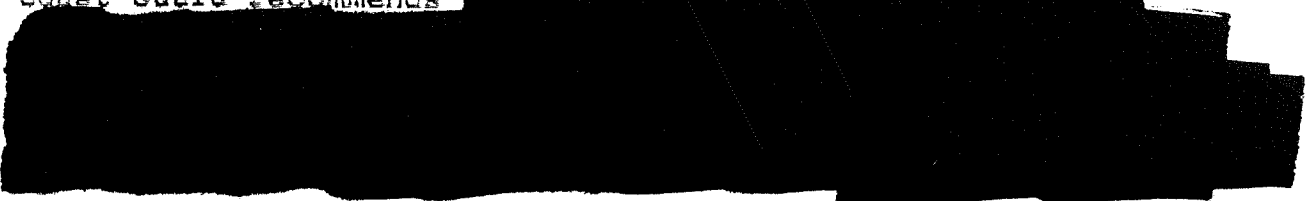
COAST GUARD'S HAITIAN AND DOMREP INTERDICTIONS FOR CY88 - CY90

Enclosed is a listing of the Coast Guard's Haitian and DOMREP interdiction cases for CY88 thru CY90.

Typical Haitian interdiction involves approximately 100 migrants and approximately one day to repatriate to Port au Prince (PAP). The migrants are interviewed by INS agents enroute from Windward Pass to PAP; interviews normally complete upon arrival. Route from patrol area to PAP takes cutter along coast of Haiti; during return to PAP, able to continue effective patrol.



To maximize the effectiveness of Coast Guard interdiction operations, and to minimize concerns for health and safety, the Coast Guard recommends
