NARRATIVE

REFERENCE: DECEASED PRINTS

ON MAY 17, 1995, THE UNDERSIGNED RECEIVED A SET OF INKED FINGERPRINTS FROM DETECTIVE TERRONES OF THE CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS SECTION ALONG WITH A REQUEST TO SEARCH THESE FINGERPRINT AGAINST OUR FINGERPRINT RECORDS IN HOPE TO POSITIVELY IDENTIFY THESE PRINTS. IT WAS EXPLAINED TO THE UNDERSIGNED THAT THESE PRINTS BELONG TO AN UNKNOWN DECEASED VICTIM ON AN ONGOING MURDER CASE IN JUAREZ, MEXICO. THIS DEPARTMENT IS MERELY ASSISTING IN THE IDENTIFICATION PORTION OF THERE CASE.

THE UNDERSIGNED THEN CHECKED THE DECEASED FINGERPRINT AGAINST THE DEPARTMENTAL FINGERPRINTS WITH A NEGATIVE RESULTS. THE DECEASED FINGERPRINTS WERE THEN SENT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY FOR A FINGERPRINTS SEARCH. THE UNDERSIGNED WAS LATER NOTIFIED THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY'S FINGERPRINT SEARCH WAS ALSO NEGATIVE AND THE FINGERPRINTS WERE SENT TO THE FBI FOR SEARCHING. ON JULY 11, 1995, THE UNDERSIGNED RECEIVED THE DECEASED FINGERPRINTS BACK FROM THE FBI. THE RESULTS OF THEIR SEARCH WAS ALSO NEGATIVE. THE DECEASED FINGERPRINTS WERE THEN FILED UNDER THIS CASE NUMBER.
