

TRAV 1820 - TRAVEL AND TOURISM (3 credits)

Selected Topics

Introductory exploration and analysis of selected topics with a specific theme indicated by course title listed in college course schedule. May be taken three times for credit as long as different topics are selected.

Upon successful completion of the course the student should be able to do the following:

1. Demonstrate knowledge of special topic presented in course.
2. Analyze current trends and research regarding the special topic presented in this course.
3. Compare and contrast different perspectives on discipline-related information to those presented on this special topic.
4. Explain the relationship of this selected topic to the main body of knowledge in the discipline.

Topical Outline:

Topics may include, but are not limited to, the following examples of specialized discipline information not covered in depth by articulated Catalog courses: legal system, history, current events, culture, literature, economics and religion.
