

TRAV 2820 - TRAVEL AND TOURISM (3 credits)

Advanced Selected Topics

Advanced exploration and analysis of selected topics with a specific theme, as indicated by course title listed in college *Class Schedule*. May be taken three times for credit as long as different topics are selected.

Upon successful completion of the course the student should be able to do the following:

1. Demonstrate knowledge of special topic presented in course.
2. Analyze current trends and research regarding the special topic presented in this course.
3. Compare and contrast different perspectives on discipline-related information to those presented in this special topic.
4. Explain the relationship of this selected topic to the main body of knowledge in the discipline.

Topical Outline:

1. Topics may include, but are not limited to the following examples of specialized discipline information not covered in-depth by articulated catalog courses: legal system, history, current events, culture, literature, economics and religion.
