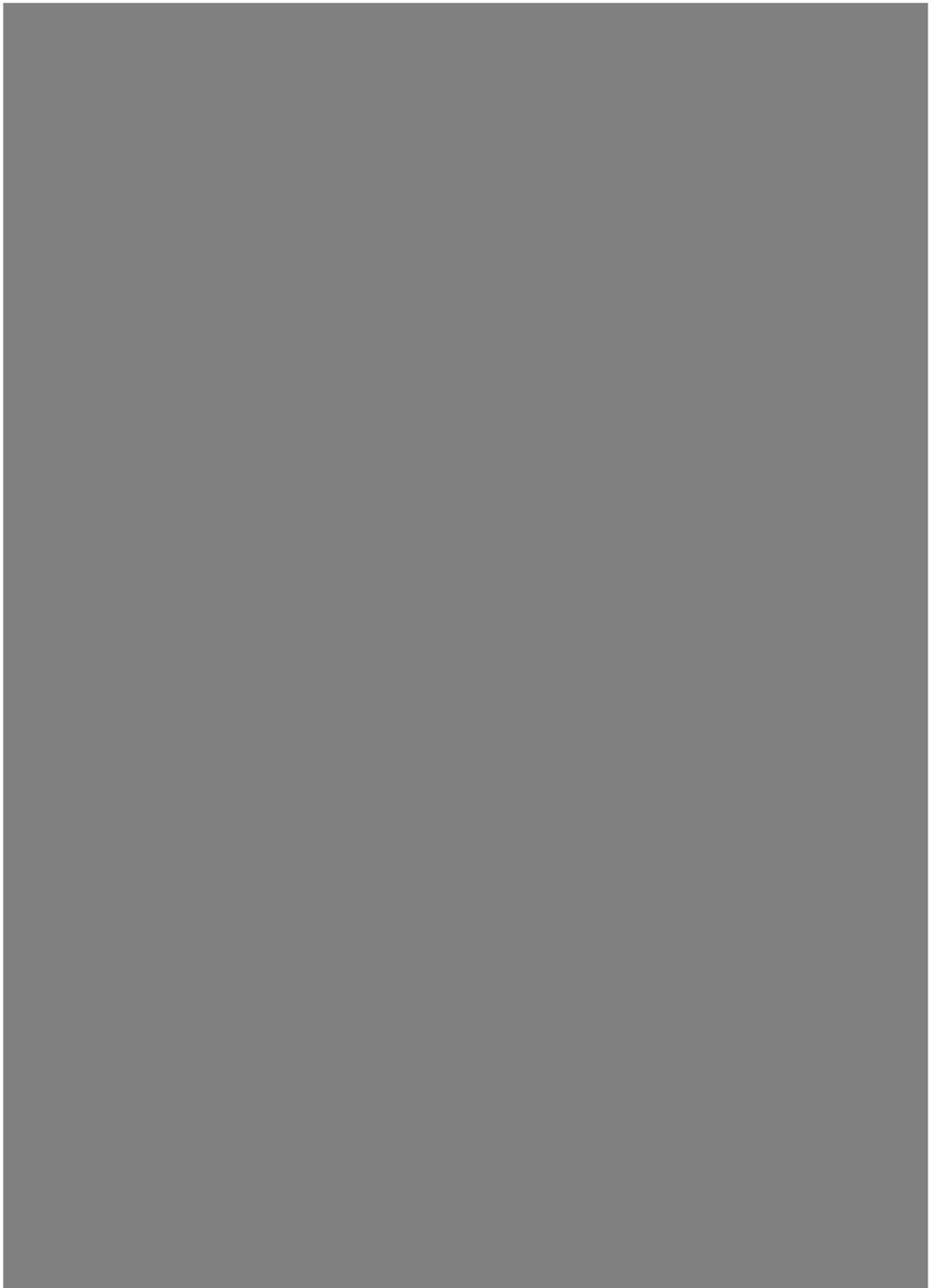

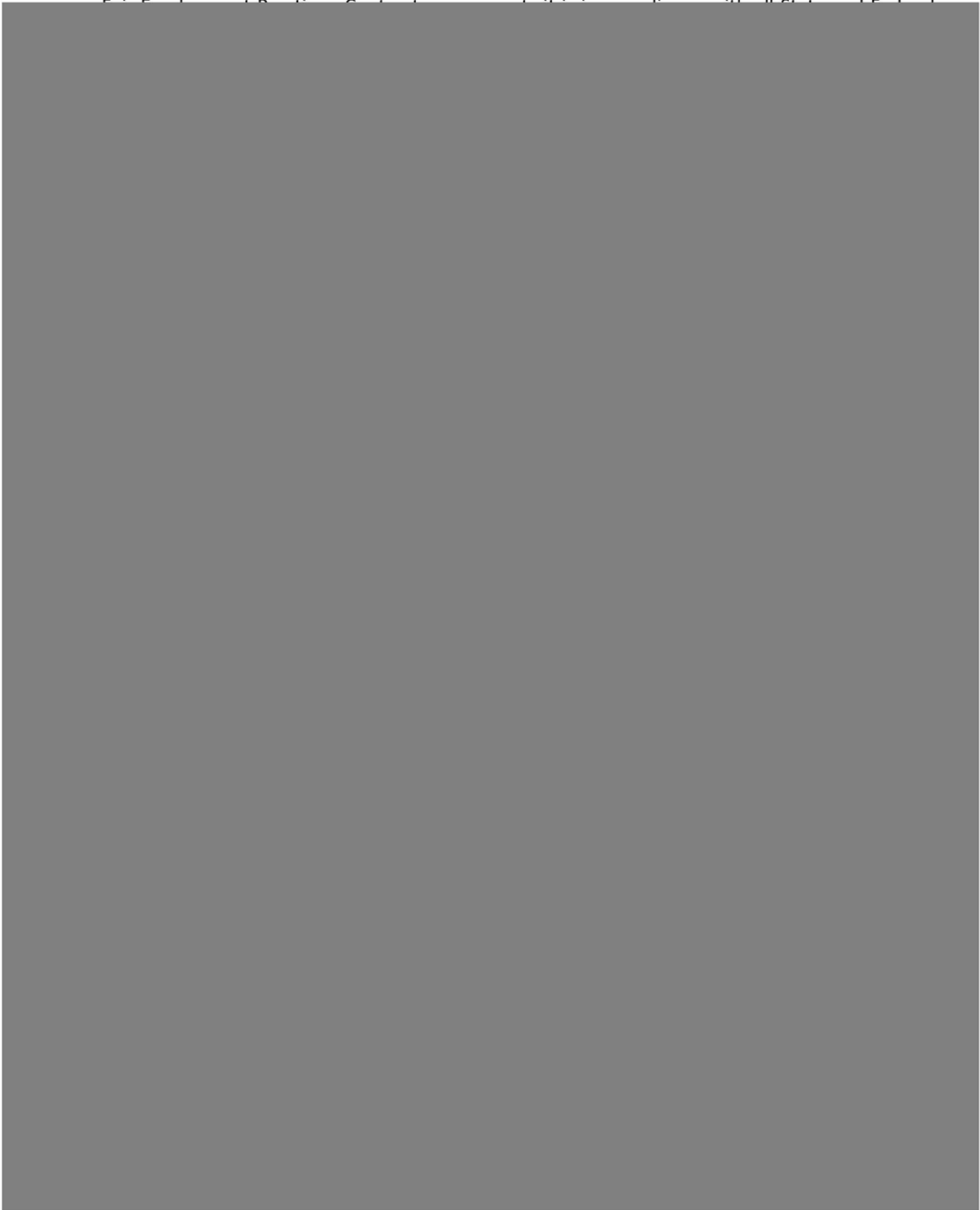
8. Default
