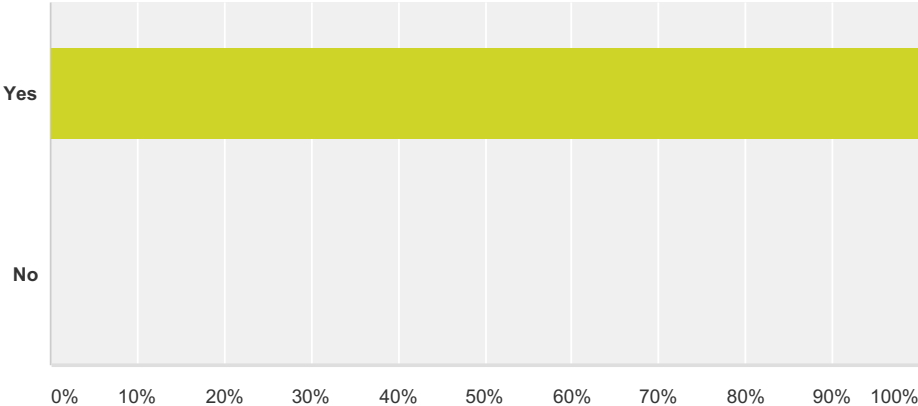

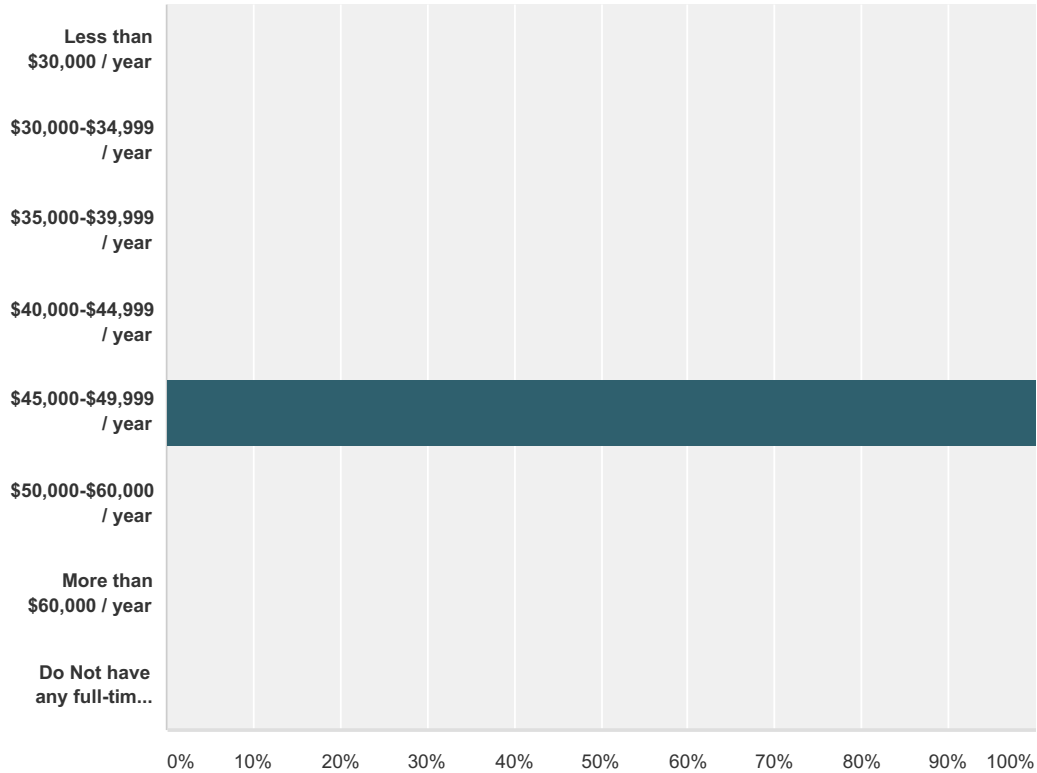

Q4 What is the starting salary range for a full-time construction management associate degree (2-year) graduate in your program?

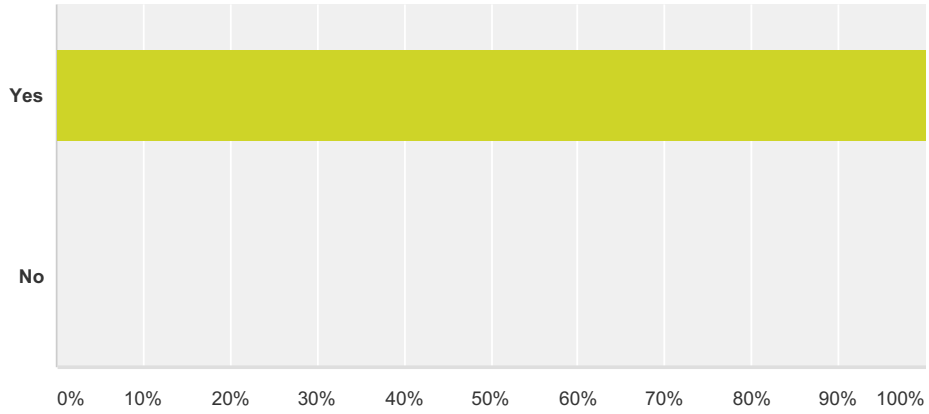

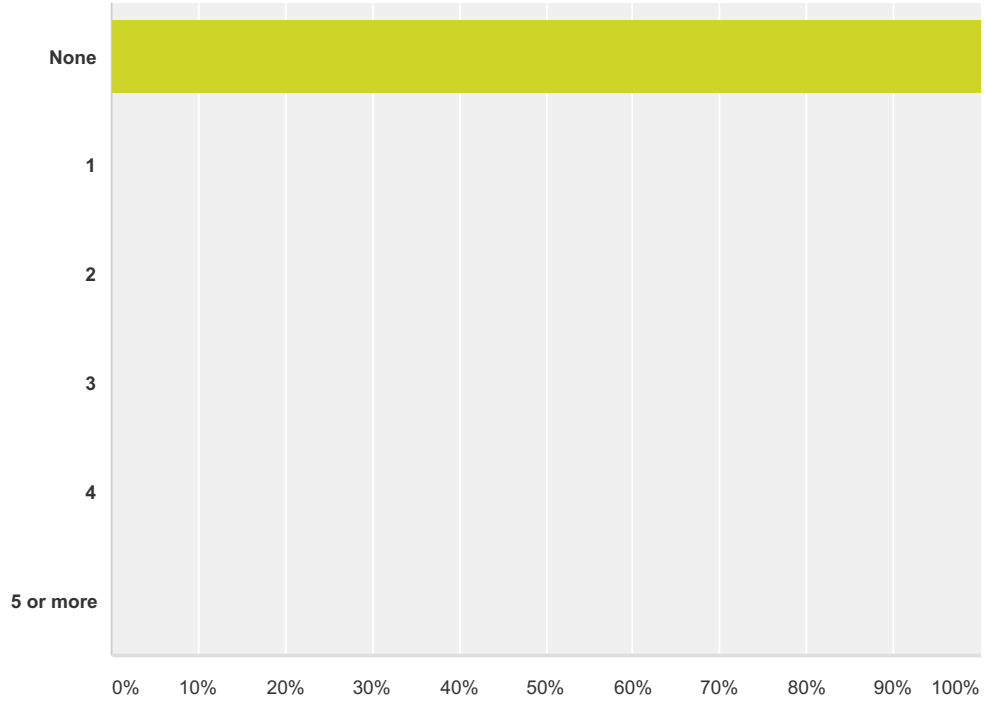
