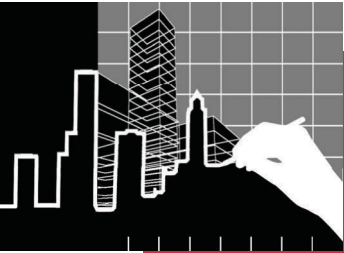


ARCHITECTURE
