Objective: To create an interesting two dimensional composition of materials, and use different techniques to illustrate the collage.
















SPATIAL SEQUENCE

Objective: Using kit of parts, create three separate seasonal spaces (Fall, Spring, and Summer), that are linked to each other by a single path.


Concept: The concept for this project explores the idea of "From struggle to success".

Fall is a season for survival, mistake, and problem. It is placed in a valley (lowest level), with darkness and tall walls.


Spring is a season for learning, opportunity and dynamic thinking. It is placed placed up-hill (middle level), getting more light from the sun.

Summer is a season for reward, celebration, and fulfillment. It is placed up-hill (the highest level) and completely open.


The path is used as a journey from making mistakes (Fall) to learning lessons (Spring) and finally find success.












CONCEPT DIAGRAM



Objective: Visit downtown Chicago, sketch and take photo of buildings that inspire you. Then, create a threedimensional collage using these photos and sketches to display your concept



Concept: The idea of the design was to show the relationship between historic and modern architecture. Sand represents historical architecture while glass represents morden architecture.


