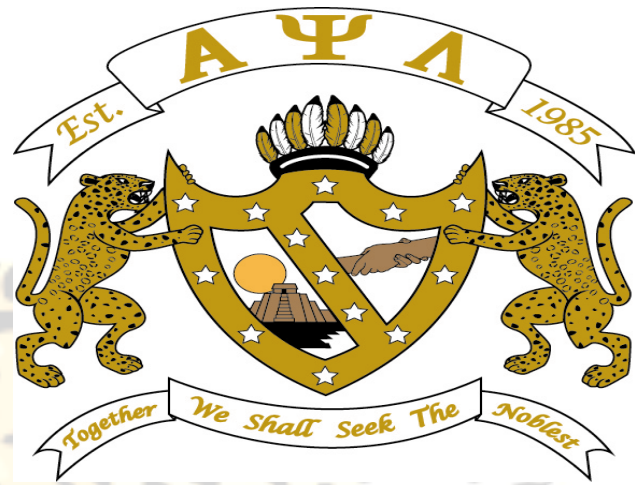


Alpha Psi Lambda- National, Inc. Scholarship Application

Zeta chapter was founded at the University of Illinois at Chicago in 1993, and since then has worked for the needs and concerns of Latino/a students. This is why, as an organization, Alpha Psi Lambda will recognize one new student in good academic standing who demonstrates outstanding leadership skills regardless of residential status. In addition, preference will be given to individuals who demonstrate financial need. The Noble brothers and sisters of Alpha Psi Lambda at Zeta Chapter are proud to announce our first Alpha Psi Lambda scholarship for \$1000.

To be eligible, a student must fulfill the following criteria:

- Must be Latino/a
- Must be a first generation student
- Not receive funds from FAFSA
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale
- Must be a high school senior or be a current student at an accredited U.S. community college or two-year institution
- Plan to attend University of Illinois at Chicago in the fall of 2015 as a full-time student

Requirements

- A copy of your high school/college transcript
- Must provide proof of enrollment into the University of Illinois at Chicago
- One letter of recommendation
- A copy of award letter/summary
